We are approaching a very busy and important time for Year 11 and as you are aware; their G.C.S.E. external examinations will soon be upon us. As part of our commitment to supporting your child through their G.C.S.E. examinations, we are offering a range of revision sessions during the Easter College Holidays. Please find overleaf a copy of the timetable. Students are not expected to wear College uniform on these days, but do need to be punctual for any sessions they wish to attend. Please note, the revision skills session on Wednesday 11th April is a drop-in session where students can discuss their own personal revision strategies with Mr Wyss at their convenience.

Students have been issued with a 'Prom Passport' and a personalised therapy timetable to encourage them to attend period 6 and holiday booster classes.
