Induction Days

Further to our Welcome Letter sent to you in March and in preparation for their September start, your child is invited into College for two Induction Days on Thursday 5th July and Friday 6th July, 2018. These days aim to support students and alleviate any unnecessary concerns that they, or you as parents/carers may have, about their transition into secondary school.

Parents/Carers are also invited to College on Thursday, 5th July, 2018 at 5.00 p.m. – 6.30 p.m. when there will be an opportunity to see presentations by the College Leadership Team who will share their vision and ethos of the College on 'Routines and Expectations', 'Progress and Attainment', 'Scholarly Habits', 'Every Day Counts' and 'Every Child Matters'. Urban Vision will also be on site with advice and guidance on road safety. The Induction Evening will provide an overview of your child's College career over the next five years.
